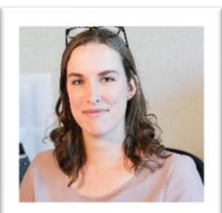

Our Keynote Speakers



Jack Dangermond is the President of Esri and is recognized as one of the most influential people in the field of geographic information system (GIS) technology. Jack, along with his wife Laura, founded Environmental Systems Research Institute (Esri) in 1969 with a vision that geographic analysis and computer mapping could help us design a better future. That vision has continued to guide Esri in creating cutting-edge GIS and Geodesign technologies used in every industry to help our users be successful and to make a difference worldwide. A graduate of Harvard University Graduate School of Design, Jack also has received 14 honorary degrees for his contributions to the fields of geography, environmental science, planning, and GIS. He is the author of *The Power of Where: A Geographic Approach to the World's Greatest Challenges*.



Anne Coglianese is the Chief Resilience Officer for the City of Jacksonville, FL. In this capacity, Anne leads the development of resilience initiatives to ensure Jacksonville can adapt and thrive in the face of acute shocks and chronic stresses brought on by climate change. Prior to joining the City of Jacksonville, Anne served as the Coastal Resilience Manager for the City of New Orleans where she implemented nature-based solutions to sea-level rise and coastal land loss. Anne's previous experience also includes serving at the White House Council on Environmental Quality, where she participated in the development of climate adaptation and resilience policies to meet the Obama Administration's resilience goals.



Jim Barnes is the Village Manager for the Village of Wellington, Florida. He has almost forty years of experience and has worked in the public and private sectors having worked in county government as well as for a multidisciplinary consulting firm before joining the Wellington team. Prior to being appointed as village manager, he held senior management roles with the Village including serving as a department director and Deputy Village Manager. Jim holds a Bachelor's degree in Geography from Florida Atlantic University, the designation as a GISP and is a certified planner with an advanced specialty certification in environmental planning from the American Institute of Certified Planners.
